

#### Chords

Augmented chord is a triad with a sharpened fifth



Half diminished chords (aka minor seven flat five chords) are built as a minor chord with a flat fifth



Fully diminished chords (aka diminished seventh) add a minor thrid above a diminished triad



### Modulation

- the change of key within a composition
- pivot chord modulation: a common chord
  - A change of tonal center within a composition, reinforced by a cadence in the new key






Half (I-V) cadence (aka an imperfect cadence or semi cadence) is any

cadence ending on V

Deceptive (V-vi)
cadence begins with
V but does not end on
the tonic.
